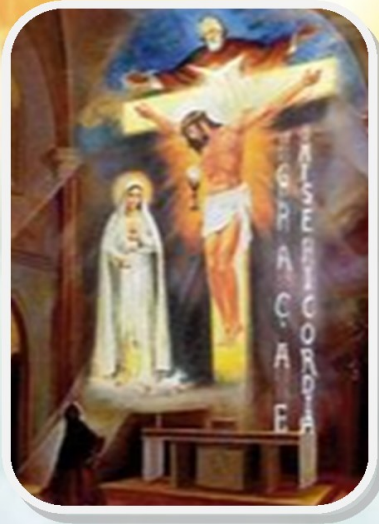
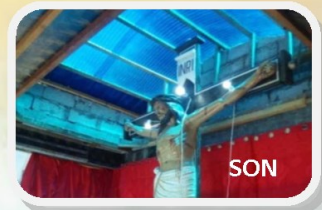
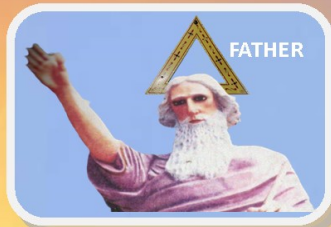

A Glimpse of Sister Lucia's  
Great Vision of the Holy Trinity

The Front Cover depicts Sister Lucia's Vision at Tuy, Spain, and a vision to action in the Philippines. "Being alone one night, I knelt down before the communion rail in the middle of the chapel to say the prayers of the Angel, lying prostrate. Feeling tired, I got up and knelt, and continued to say them with my arms in the form of a cross. The only light came from the sanctuary lamp. Suddenly a supernatural light illumined the whole chapel and on the altar appeared a cross of light which reached to the ceiling. In a brighter part could be seen, on the upper part of the Cross, the face of a man and His body to the waist; on His breast was an equally luminous dove, and nailed to the cross, the body of another man. A little below the waist, suspended in mid-air, was to be seen a Chalice and a large Host onto which fell some drops of Blood from the face of the Crucified and from a wound in His breast. These drops ran down over the Host and fell into the Chalice. Under the right arm of the Cross was Our Lady with Her Immaculate Heart in Her hand... (It was Our Lady of Fatima with Her Immaculate Heart... in Her left hand... without a sword or roses, but with a crown of thorns and flames...). Under the left arm (of the Cross), some big letters, as it were of crystal clear water running down over the Altar, formed these words: "Grace and Mercy." I understood that it was the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity that was shown to me, and I received lights about this mystery which I am not permitted to reveal. Then Our Lady said to me: "The moment has come when God asks the Holy Father to make, in union with all the bishops of the world, the consecration of Russia to My Immaculate Heart, promising to save it by this means. So numerous are the souls which the justice of God condemns for sins committed against Me, that I come to ask for reparation. Sacrifice yourself for this Intention and pray."

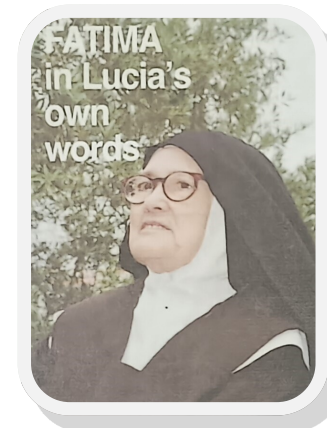

## The Story of the God the Father Tower

Conceptualized by Architect Gerardo Ocampo, the God the Father Tower describes as “an equilateral triangle with its major axis pointing at approximately 80 degrees northwest to the Holy City of Jerusalem from Luzon, its two sides facing the vastness of the ocean and overlooking San Fernando Bay. Its design is concentrated on the Arabic number three which signifies the Holy Trinity. It has three stages, each stage diminishing in height in a regular pattern following a three degree tapering of the columns from the vertical. It is 12 meters from the base to the top deck and this 12 meters height represents the 12 original tribes of Israel. It can be reached by a twin semi-circular stairs. A special feature of the design is an incorporation of three level water tanks suspended from beams in the three stages, to serve as pendulums when earthquake occurs.



## The Pendulum Damper

A pendulum damper is a device used in structures to absorb energy and dampen vibrations. It consists of a heavy mass suspended from a spring, allowing it to oscillate back and forth. When subjected to external forces, the pendulum swings, dissipating the energy and preventing excessive movement of the structure.

Figuratively the pendulum damper signifies the pendulum of faith. It is a critical element to keep one's foundation from the relentless forces of nature.

In many ways, our faith is akin to a pendulum damper for our lives. It provides a stabilizing force, anchoring us amidst the storms of life. Just as the pendulum absorbs the energy of vibrations, our faith absorbs the shocks and stresses we encounter.

When faced with challenges, doubts, or uncertainties, our faith can swing back and forth. We may question our beliefs, grapple with our fears, or feel disconnected from a higher power. But like the pendulum, our faith can find its equilibrium, returning us to a place of centeredness and strength.

The above quotation from US President Robert F. Kennedy was shared to us by Engr. Ernesto Runas in a video taken October 17, 2024. Engr. Runas acknowledges that the God the Father Tower is the idea of Luz brother-in-law, third placer in the Architecture Board Exam.



## Jacob's Ladder

In this dream, Jacob envisions a ladder, or stairway, that reaches from Earth to Heaven. Angels are seen ascending and descending on the ladder. He is so convinced of the holiness of the place where the Lord visited him that he decides to rename it. Previously called Luz, the place will now be known as Bethel. The word Bethel means “House of God.”



## The Columns

The Roman columns played an important role in ancient architecture and had both structural and aesthetic purposes. They supported buildings while adding grandeur and elegance to public spaces. With styles such as Doric, Ionic, and Corinthian, Roman columns continue to be used as a tribute to classical design..



## The Chapel

Coincidentally, the sculptor offered to Twin Luz the image of the Crucified Christ because the former customer failed to claim.





The Stained glass of the visionaries was made by Rene Gooch of REGO STAINED GLASS from Pangasinan. The design of Our Lady of Fatima and the three visionaries \_ an original stained glass panel measuring 3 ft. x 5.5 ft.

The Altar table is made of marble from Romblon measuring 118" x 39" by Alma Gurion of Aeg Poolbuilders. Both the stained glass and the altar table were blessed on September 26, 2024, Feasts of Saints Cosmas and Damian, patron saint of twins.

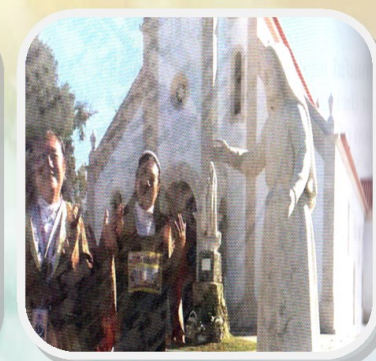


Inside Front Cover Continuation ... A Glimpse...

The vision that happened in Tuy, Spain on June 13, 1929, actualized on the 25th Anniversary of the La Union Consecration of the Philippines to God the Father on October 19, 2024.

The Lord has made holy “Bantay ni Ama ken Maria” (Mountain of Father and Mary) at Pag-daraoan, City of San Fernando, La Union, Philippines where He dwells; this is the House of God, in which His Name will be invoked, as it is written: ‘My name Sea and Sky God the Father Tower shall be there, says the Lord.’ The equilateral triangle is a symbol of the Holy Trinity. God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit are no longer represented in human form, or as dove, but by this geometrical figure. This ‘God-Logo’ is placed on the head of God the Father statue. Holy Spirit figure: Central to Catholic teaching are the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. The image of the Crucified Christ: God the Son statue had witnessed the making of the God the Father statue at the sculptor shop. The owner offered to Luz because the former customer failed to claim. The image was transferred from the Sea and Sky College to the chapel in Sea and Sky God the Father Tower on September 29, 2024. Our Lady of Fatima and the Three Children original stained glass panel by Renmark R. Gooc, Philippines. Sister Lucia added her 11th commandment: “Do whatever God tells you. That is what Our Lady wants.”

True to the Carmelite Spirit doing the “Little Way” the Ortega Twins of the Philippines offer this document as contribution towards the Canonization of Venerable Lucia.
